- Candidates must have a current GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Application MUST include a current official copy of your high school transcript, available through the DHS Counseling Office.
- Application MUST include one recommendation from teacher, club sponsor, coach, instructor, or employer on the form provided.

IF THESE CONDITIONS ARE NOT MET, YOUR APPLICATION WILL BE INVALID, AND YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION.

- Valid applications will be impartially scored using a point system by the PTSO Award Committee to determine finalists.
- Typing of applications is encouraged but not required.
- Finalists will interview with an independent panel selected by the PTSO on February 22, 2019 (Date subject to change).
- Failure to keep the interview appointment will remove the finalist from the process.
- The decision of the independent interview panel and the PTSO Award Committee is final.

The recipients of the DHS PTSO Outstanding Senior Award will be notified by the end of March 2019. The recipients will be recognized and presented with awards during the spring Honors Day Program at Dunwoody High School in May.
