
## CLASS OF 2018 SENIORS' LAST BLAST MAY 21-22 INFO, WAIVER & REGISTRATION



Seniors' Last Blast is a fun, safe, overnight lock-in for all seniors held on the night of graduation. The party starts Monday May 21 at 11:00 p.m. and ends at 5:00 a.m. Tuesday May 22. At this chaperoned event, there are **NO DRUGS and NO ALCOHOL.** There will be games, music, food, prizes, and fun with friends to keep everyone awake and busy all night!

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This year Seniors' Last Blast will be held at the Main Event in Alpharetta. Included in the \$55 admission price is unlimited Laser Tag, Ropes Course, Arcade and Electronic Games, Billiards, Bowling and Prize Giveaways. We will have an All-You-Can-Eat Pizza Bar, chips, dip, cookies, and drinks will be available throughout the night, and a Continental Breakfast will be served in the morning prior to departure. Everyone will be transported from DHS by bus to and from The Main Event. Students will not be allowed to drive private vehicles to the Main Event, and may not be dropped off at the venue. They MUST ride the buses both ways, no exceptions except medical emergency.

To purchase admission, sign the attached registration and waiver forms and drop off at the DHS Front Office or mail with your check to: Liz Joyce 1329 Mile Post Drive Dunwoody, Ga 30338. Make checks payable to DHS PTSO. We cannot accept any registration without the DHS registration form/waiver. There will be forms in the front office and they are posted on the senior page on the school website. There will be opportunities to register at school later in the semester, but we request registrations as soon as possible for planning purposes. Registration deadline is May 10th, 2018.

We greatly appreciate any amount you can give over and above the \$55 admission. This money will go towards covering the cost for students who would otherwise be unable to attend as well as help bridge the actual per student cost of \$75.

## Graduation Night May 21

- Students check in at DHS from 11:00 until 11:30 p.m. Everyone must show a valid ID and NO ONE will be allowed on the buses unless they have turned in the signed waiver.
- There will be Dekalb County School Police on site at check-in and at The Main Event. If they deem a student unfit to participate, the parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child. That student will not be allowed to go, and there will be no refunds. Officer Bell and parent chaperones will be monitoring restrooms etc at The Main Event; if there is a problem a parent will be contacted to come get the student/s and disciplinary procedures may follow.
- No backpacks unless medically necessary and this needs to be pre-approved.
- When students check in at DHS they will transfer all personal items to a ziplock bag before they load the bus. The ziplock bag will be checked in a secure area during the event. All purses and bags should be left at home. The restrooms will be stocked with feminine products.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the Main Event early unless it is a medical emergency. Students are free to leave DHS on their own after the buses return Friday morning.
- If a student has not checked in at DHS by 11:30 p.m. when the buses leave, every attempt will be made to contact the parent so they are aware that their child did not attend the event. If we cannot reach a parent by phone we will send a text message.
- Times will be strictly enforced. We will not hold the buses waiting for stragglers.
- All registrations must be purchased in advance no registrations may be purchased on Thursday night.
- There are no refunds after May 15th. If your child misses the bus, they will miss the event and forfeit the ticket price.
