Dunwoody High School is a traditional high school in the DeKalb County School District serving grades 9 through 12. Dunwoody is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and the Georgia Department. of Education Accrediting Commission. The enrollment for the 2015-2016 school year is approximately 1700 students, with 343 students in the graduating class of 2016.

BLOCK SCHEDULE

Dunwoody High School operates on a two-semester system and uses a 4x4 block schedule. Most classes meet for 90 minutes each day, five days per week, for 18 weeks totaling 135 contact hours per course. Students have the opportunity to earn 32 credits, opposed to the traditional 28; allowing for more AP credits before college.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

Dunwoody offers students a variety of educational opportunities to further their educational goals.

Academies

<u>Academy of Finance</u> is a two-year program for students to explore a career in business, marketing, and finance. This program focuses on finance, accounting, computer applications, and public speaking. Some students secure paid summer internships with local businesses.

Academy of Mass Communications is a two-year program that builds an educational foundation for a future in the communications industry. Students have the unique opportunity to experience specialized journalism training. Students receive hands-on training in video production, interviewing techniques, and newspaper layout.

<u>Academy of Engineering and Technology</u> trains students to apply math/science in real-world design challenges; STEM workshops build leadership, entrepreneurship and problem-solving skills; competitions at state, national, and world levels. Includes biotechnology, electronic circuits, control systems, robotics, software development, video game design, webmaster, and much more.

Air Force ROTC

The AFJROTC Aerospace Science and Leadership Education program is a blend of science, social science, leadership, technical course work, and training in drill and ceremonies.

Joint Enrollment/Post Secondary Option

Many students take advantage of the proximity of Georgia State University/Perimeter College by registering for courses taught there. Currently 100 seniors are enrolled in PSO courses.
