## Dress Code Policy

Students who fail to comply with the school and/or district-wide dress code requirements, as listed below, may be charged with Offense #25 – Student Dress Code Violation and/or Offense #19a – Repeated Violation of School Rules (Code of Student Conduct-Student Rights and Responsibilities and Character Development Handbook).

The following are **NOT** allowed at Dunwoody High School:



- Halter/ tank/ tube/ sheer tops, spaghetti straps, extremely low-cut tops, or tops revealing under-garments
- Running/biking shorts (all skirts/shorts must be fingertip length)
- Ear buds, head phones, and air pods in both ears; *however, students are allowed to wear one in, one out during transitions and lunch.*
- Sleepwear
- Blankets
- All pants must be worn at waist level.
- Sunglasses, hats, caps, bandanas, or any kind of headwear (except those worn for religious purposes)
- Offensive clothing, language, images, or insignia which promote gangs or the use of controlled substances, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco are prohibited.
