

The Georgia Milestones End of Course Assessments will be administered in person at Dunwoody High School

All tests begin at 8:00 AM each day. Students may arrive as early as 7:45.

The Winter EOC administration will follow a ONE-day test schedule as detailed below.

- All individuals entering DHS are required to wear a mask/face covering for the entire time they are present in the building.
- Students should bring their fully charged DCSD issued Chromebook. If they do not have one, we will provide a device.
- All water fountains are closed; Students may bring bottled water.
- There will not be more than 15 students assigned to a testing room. Students will be seated with at least six feet between them.
- DCSD will provide bus transportation to and from Dunwoody High School for students who
 requested transportation through the survey. Transportation WILL NOT be provided for
 make-up days. Bus routes will be published as soon as we receive them.
- Students may drive and park on campus on test days.
- Students not testing during the December Testing window will receive an "Incomplete" on their report card until the EOC Assessment requirement is satisfied. Students will be afforded a make-up opportunity as identified in the <u>DCSD Assessment Calendar</u> as EOC Mid-Month Assessments.
- ** Dunwoody High School and The DeKalb County School District will follow all Georgia Health Department and the Center for Disease Control Health and Safety Guidelines as related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Frequently Asked Questions					
Will the EOC's take place inside DHS, or virtually?	All EOC Assessments are in person. The Georgia Department of Education has not made provisions for a virtual test environment for the End of Course (EOC) Assessment administrations due to test security protocols.				
What is the protocol for students who are uncomfortable/not willing to take the EOC?	Families not comfortable with sending their students into the building for testing have the right to keep their students at home. DCSD has always had protocols for students who miss EOC Assessments. Provision will be made for those students to make-up tests at a later date during Spring Semester as identified in the DCSD Assessment Calendar as EOC Mid-Month Assessments.				
Students will be absent from other classes while testing. How is this addressed?	Testing is a school activity; therefore, students will be considered present and their attendance will reflect this.				
What is the weight of the EOC?	Superintendent Woods and the State Board of Education (SBOE) recommend that the Georgia Milestones End-of-Course (EOC) percentage weight to be included in a student's final grade be reduced from 20% to .01% for the 2020-2021 school year. No decision has not been made.				
For the Algebra EOC, do we know what calculator and graphing tools students will have?	Although there is a calculator imbedded within the EOC Platform, students may bring a handheld calculator to use. Students MUST be familiar enough with the calculator to clear the memory. Teachers are not expected to assist with clearing calculator memories.
