Tips for Seniors Applying to College

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- The counselors will be processing transcript & letter of recommendation requests Aug 27th Dec 7th and Jan 10th May 3rd.
- The Counseling Office will not accept transcript requests after December 7th in order to meet college deadlines in January.

HOW TO START YOUR APPLICATION

- Applying online is the quickest and easiest way. To apply to Georgia Colleges and Universities, go to GAFutures.org.
- Remember to provide only what is requested on the application. Complete your application <u>exactly</u> as directed. Do not add information, recommendations, personal data sheet, etc. when it is not requested.
- If applying to a college or university in the state of Georgia, you may request an electronic transcript via GAFutures.org.
- For non-electronic transcript requests, you should provide an addressed, stamped envelope with your name only in the upper left corner of the envelope for identification purposes. Give this envelope to Mrs. Harris in the counseling office.
- If requesting electronic transcripts for non-Georgia schools, please contact your counselor directly (for example: Common Application and Coalition).

COUNSELOR/TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- Always give your counselor/teacher the recommendation form 3 weeks prior to the school's application deadline.
- Counselor/Teacher recommendations are mailed separately from the application. You must provide your counselor/teacher with a stamped envelope addressed to the college for mailing your recommendation unless an electronic option is available.
