Only thing left is to get School Board approval – was supposed to be on February agenda, but will likely be moved to March agenda for approval.

New Business -

- Electronic voting should be in place for School Council elections.
- Discussion of legislative issues impacting the school district.
- City representatives are already trying to meet with new interim Superintendent Thurmond concerning GAC accreditation of DHS.
- FEB 21st State BOE hearing will be live streaming on web.
- Summer Assignments council recommendation to consider having no summer assignments administration to consider.
- Financial policies & procedures for school booster and extracurricular clubs Recommendation by Council that financial controls be put in place this semester. Consider requiring all booster clubs and other school clubs either have a 501C3 designation or else ALL checks must be funneled through DHS.
- SAT Day April 17th ALL Juniors will be taking the SAT at school for free fee paid for by the State.
