Applications must be filled out completely and returned in a sealed envelope to Ms. Love in the Dunwoody High School Counseling Office no later than **Friday, January 20, 2017.**

- 1. IMPORTANT! PTSO membership during the 2016-2017 school year is required (cost \$5). Confirm membership with PTSO Treasurer, Suzie Martin: [suziemartin@comcast.net](mailto:suziemartin@comcast.net)**
- 2. Candidates must have a current GPA at 3.0 or higher.**
- 3. Application MUST include a current official copy of your high school transcript, available through the DHS Counseling Office.**
- 4. Application MUST include one teacher recommendation or recommendation from a club sponsor, coach, instructor or employer on the form provided.**

**IF THESE FOUR CONDITIONS ARE NOT MET, YOUR APPLICATION WILL BE INVALID AND YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION.**

- ❖ Valid applications will be impartially scored using a point system by the PTSO Award Committee to determine finalists.
- ❖ Typing of applications is encouraged but not required.
- ❖ Finalists will interview with an independent panel selected by the PTSO on February 20, 2017 (Date subject to change).
- ❖ Failure to keep the interview appointment will remove the finalist from the process.
- ❖ The decision of the independent interview panel and the PTSO Award Committee is final.

The two PTSO Outstanding Senior Award for Seniors pursuing a four year degree winners will be notified by the end of March 2017. They will be recognized and presented with their awards at the spring Honors Day Program at Dunwoody High School in May.
