Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

The Georgia Board of Education requires all students who are enrolled for credit in any of the courses listed below to take the Georgia Milestones End of Course (EOC) Assessment upon course completion. The following four courses have EOCs:

- American Literature/Composition
  Coordinate Algebra/Algebra 1
- U.S. HistoryBiology

According to the GADOE, the EOC serves as the final exam for the courses listed above. The Board established a grade of 70 as the "passing score" for the EOC for all courses. For a student to receive credit for a course, the average of the coursework and the EOC score must equal or exceed 70. (See Georgia SBOE rule 160-4-2-.13.)

Below are Dunwoody High School's 2021 EOC Spring Main EOC test administration procedures:

- $\checkmark$  Students will test at Dunwoody HS in person during the block they normally attend class.
- ✓ To adequately prepare, students learning remotely are asked to register for the EOC exam using the QR Code at the right. Please complete by 12:00 PM on Friday, April 16, 2021. →
- ✓ Families not comfortable with their students coming into the building should also indicate that by clicking here or using the QR Code.
- ✓ Students must wear a face covering or mask for the entire test administration.
- ✓ Students must bring their DCSD issued Chromebook <u>fully charged</u> if applicable.
- ✓ If students are showing signs of fever, cough, runny nose, chills, and other cold-like symptoms, they should not participate in this administration.

It is the expectation that every student enrolled in one or more of the four courses identified above take the End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment. Students who fail to take the End-of-Course (as required) during this testing window, must do so by the end of the next subsequent grading period in June 2021 or their grade will default to a grade of 0%.
