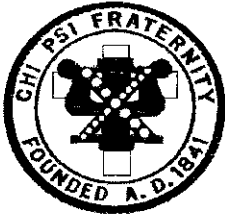

Scholarship Opportunity for incoming Georgia Tech students

Alpha Iota Delta of Chi Psi Fraternity is proud to announce the Bryan Scholarship (formerly the Bethel Scholarship prior to 2013) to the Georgia Institute of Technology. The scholarship is sponsored by the Robert B. Plunkett Memorial Educational Trust. This year, we are offering one scholarship of \$1,000 to a qualified young man entering Georgia Tech in the fall of 2022.

The scholarship is being offered by the fraternity in memory of Oscar Virgil Bryan, Jr., 1A '67, who was continually involved in his fraternity and his community as a generous philanthropist and leader. The scholarship is available to any senior male student who will be graduating high school in 2022 and who will be attending the Georgia Institute of Technology. It will be awarded to the young man who best exemplifies the selfless ideals of our fraternity as demonstrated by Brother Bryan, including a drive for academic excellence, devotion to building lifelong relationships, dedication to philanthropy, and overall pursuit of excellence.

The written application, accompanied by an official transcript, must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2022. A committee will screen the applications, and the semi-finalists will be announced on May 31, 2022. These finalists will receive a letter with more detailed information on the next steps, including an interview during the month of June or July in the metro Atlanta area. The winner will be announced at a banquet in Atlanta in August.
