



Class of 2022



- **Senior Week** will be April 25 – 29, 2022! More details about the activities/events will be provided.
- **Final exams** for seniors will be Monday, 5/9/22 (3rd & 4th period) and Tuesday, 5/10/21 (1st & 2nd period). Seniors' last day will be May 10th. Information about senior exam exemptions will be provided later.
- **Graduation practice** will be May 10th beginning at the beginning of 3rd period on the Football field.
- **Dues** must be paid prior to receiving the cap and gown. If you have not paid your senior dues, please do so ASAP. Senior dues are \$135. If you have already paid you do not need to pay once again.
- **Chromebooks** - If you are currently not using the school assigned Chromebook, you are to return on to the main office.
- **Overdue media center** books should be returned ASAP
- **Cap and gown distribution and Chromebook collection** for seniors will be Tuesday, April 26 and Wednesday, April 26th. If there is a change in the schedule you will be notified.
- DCSD will host **graduation ceremonies** for all high schools at James Hallford Stadium for the Class of 2022. Dunwoody High School's graduation is scheduled for May 16, 2022 at 11:30am. Masks are strongly encouraged during the ceremony.
- **Media release** forms and **transportation forms** were due on April 12th, 2022. If you do not turn in a media release form, you will not be videoed for the live stream. If you do not turn in a transportation form, you will not be allowed to ride the bus to or from the ceremony.
- WE WOULD LIKE ALL GRADUATES ride the District provided Coach buses to the graduation venue, Hallford Stadium. ALL GRADUATES must meet at DHS by 8:30am to load the buses. The buses will leave DHS at 9:00am on May 16th. If you miss the Coach bus, plan to arrive at the venue no later than 10:15am. The graduation ceremony will not wait for you to arrive; the ceremony will start PROMPTLY at 11:30am. Coach buses leave the stadium after the ceremony at 12:30pm.
- Each graduate will receive 12 tickets to attend graduation (distribution time TBD). DCSD will be live streaming the ceremony for all of those who cannot physically attend.

GRADUATION DRESS CODE

- Caps should be placed on the head so that the mortarboard is level. The front of the cap is indicated on the inside of the crown. Caps are never worn on the back of the head. For graduation, caps are worn parallel to the ground with the point in the center of the forehead. Caps should be held in place with bobby pins. At the beginning of the ceremony, tassels are positioned **ON THE RIGHT**.
- **You are allowed to DECORATE your Cap. However, absolutely NO 3D elements, NO feathers or light up items, and NOTHING hanging from the cap or gown. If your cap has prohibited items, it will be taken and replaced by a plain cap. If your gown contains prohibited items, you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.**

Cell Phones & handbags - Graduates may wear a small fanny pack or cross body handbag **UNDER** their gown. Cell phones must be silenced during the ceremony.
