# The Hub DHS Library Learning Commons FAQ:

# 1. How do I print?

<u>For black and white copies</u>, select the "black & white 10 cents/page" printer. It may also say, "LaserJet 4050."

<u>For color,</u> you must see Ms. Hawk, Mrs. Lee or one of the parent volunteers. <u>**DO NOT CLICK "PRINT" before you have permission.**</del></u>

# 2. How much does it cost to print?

Black and white copies: \$.10 per page.

<u>Color copies</u>: \$.50 per page depending on the usage of ink. <u>You must see Ms. Hawk, Mrs. Lee, or a parent</u> volunteer before you print.

# 3. Can I make copies?

Yes, see Ms. Hawk or Mrs. Lee (\$.10 per black & white copy, \$.50 per color copy).

# 4. What if I cannot log on?

Your account may be locked. Proceed to the circulation desk and ask **Ms. Hawk or Mrs. Lee** for your login to be reset.

# 5. How do I look for a book in the library?

Go to the Dunwoody High School webpage, go to "Quick Links", click <u>The Hub: Library Learning Commons</u> (Media Center), and click <u>Access: Follett Destiny</u> and search.

# 6. What if the book I am looking for is not available?

A book may be placed on hold. Once it is in, you will receive a notification from one of your teachers.

#### 7. How many books may I check out & how long may I keep them?

You may check out up to five (5) books at a time for two weeks. Overdue fines are \$0.10 per school day. If you need to keep a book for longer than two weeks, you may bring it to the library on or before the due date to renew it for an additional two weeks.

# 8. I have a fine; can I still check out?

No, if you have an overdue book or any fines, including printing fees, then you will not be able to check out any books until all fines & fees are paid.

## 9. What do I do if I lose my library book?

You must pay the full replacement price of the book, plus a \$1.00 non-refundable processing fee. Please see **Ms. Hawk**.

## 10. May I check out a reference book?

Yes, reference books may be checked out after school for <u>overnight</u> use. They must be returned by 8:05 the <u>next school day</u>. Overdue fines are **\$0.25 per hour**. Reference books may not be renewed.

# \*\*REMINDERS\*\*

- 1. No eating or drinking in the library except water in a sealable container. You must place all drinks and food on the plastic tray upon arrival.
- 2. Computers are NOT meant for browsing, playing games, or checking your personal email or social media. Computers are to be used for school assignments <u>ONLY</u> (including filling out college applications, registering or studying for the SAT/ACT, etc.).
