Instructions for New Students

Step 1: Review the approved dual enrollment courses on the GA Futures website - <https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/scholarships-grants/dual-enrollment/course-directory-2020-2021-beginning-summer-term-2020/>

Step 2: After you have reviewed the list of approved courses, please use the form below to indicate which course(s) you plan to take. This form must be completed by October 9, 2020. This is an internal document that helps us identify the course(s) our dual enrollment students are taking. *Please note that this form does not register you for the course(s).*

Step 3: Apply for dual enrollment through the GSU website. While the firm deadline to apply with all supporting admission documents is November 1, you are encouraged to apply by October 1 to increase your chances of getting classes and registering in a timely manner - <https://perimeter.gsu.edu/admissions/dual-enrollment/>

Dual Enrollment - Perimeter College

Dual enrollment students at Perimeter College can take courses at any of our five Perimeter campuses or online. 1000- and 2000-level courses only are available through Perimeter. Dual enrollment students at our Atlanta Campus attend classes on the Atlanta Campus only and have a few options for 3000- and 4000-level courses.

Any prospective Dual Enrollment student who applies and/or submits supporting document (for an admission decision) after Nov. 1st will not be processed for the Spring 2021 semester.

Step 4: Send an email to Ms. Nakita Jackson (nakita_jackson@dekalbschoolsga.org) indicating that you have applied for dual enrollment and need to have your transcripts submitted. **This step must be completed by Friday, October 23 in order to ensure that your transcripts are received by the November 1 deadline.**

A completed file is a GSU undergraduate application, official high school transcript, and Standard test scores (ACT/SAT/ACCUPLACER)*

*Evidence of successfully completing Algebra II can be substituted for standardized test scores. A full year of Algebra II must be on the high school transcript at the time of applying to the Dual Enrollment program at Georgia State University.

Information on taking the ACCUPLACER through Examity and on campus at GSU can be found at <https://counselingcenter.gsu.edu/testing/accuplacer/>. Please note, students must have a Panther ID number.

Step 5: Complete the GA Futures online Student Parent Agreement and Funding Application on the GA Futures website. **This form must be completed by October 9, 2020.** - <https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/scholarships-grants/dual-enrollment/application-procedure-and-deadline/>

Georgia State University no longer accepts any form of the paper Student Participation Agreement (SPA) form. High Schools will be required to enter their students' Spring 2021 courses in Ga Futures.

Please note, students will not be cleared to register for Spring 2021 classes without courses listed in Ga Futures. In addition, Dual Enrollment students should only register for courses listed in Ga Futures.

Step 6: Spring 2021 Courses will be added in GAFutures.org **only** for students that complete the Dunwoody High School Dual Enrollment Form for Spring 2021 by **October 9, 2020**. Your status should change to "PSI Decision Pending" instead of "Application Pending". Please see the link below:

Dual Enrollment FAQ's

WHO ARE THE STUDENTS THAT NEED TO COMPLETE A REACTIVATION APPLICATION?

Students who were admitted for prior terms (Spring, Summer, Fall 2020) and did not enroll/register, must complete the reactivation application; Please refer to the above deadline dates. Students should email admissions@gsu.edu with questions. Students must allow up to 21 business days to receive an Admission decision after they have a completed file.

Below is a timeline to assist students to transition into the Spring 2021 registration period

Oct 2nd: “The more you know” Virtual Registration Drive. This virtual drive is only for current DE students.

Oct. 9th: Deadline to submit/upload immunization record to the student patient portal. Current DE students who do not upload their immunization record by Oct. 9th may not be cleared for registration on Nov. 2nd. Registration may be delayed by two (2) weeks. For assistance with uploading immunization records, please contact 404-413-1941.

Oct. 9th: Last day for students to withdraw from GSU with a “WP – withdraw pass” on their GSU transcript and the last day for Dual Enrollment students to pick up their GSU textbook(s) and textbook code(s) from the GSU bookstore for the Fall 2020 semester. All withdraw approvals must be emailed from the HS counselor and include the student’s name and a list of course(s) that the student may withdraw from.

Oct. 16th: Deadline for students to submit AP scores, official college transcripts from other institutions and complete placement exams for Math, Science, and Foreign Language courses (if applicable). DE students who do not submit applicable AP scores, college transcripts and placement exams by Oct. 16th may not be cleared for registration on Nov. 2nd. Registration may be delayed by two (2) weeks.

Oct. 26th: Online Orientation will become available to new students applying to the Spring 2021 semester (link will be sent to their Panthermail email accounts).

Nov. TBA: Dual Enrollment registration opens for the Spring 2021 semester (tentatively Nov. 2nd). GSU will check schedules every Friday and students may automatically be dropped for registering for courses not included on their Ga Futures electronic application.

Nov. 27th: Dual Enrollment registration ends. GSU will check schedules every Friday and students may automatically be dropped for registering for courses not included on their Ga Futures electronic application.
