

Service Above Self Scholarship – 2019-20 School Year Fact Sheet

To Apply

- Student must have been enrolled in Dunwoody High School for at least one complete school year at the time of application
- Student must apply no later than February 28, 2020 to Mary Sturken

Application To Include:

- List of all group or individual extracurricular school activities, may include any job
- List of any leadership role or responsibility undertaken within the school
- Name, address and telephone number of at least two references who can attest to student's character
- Recommendation letters from at least two staff sponsors
- Student Essay Brief summary in the form of an essay of main events in student's life to include personal as well as educational goals (1,000 -1,500 words)

To Receive Initial Scholarship

- Student must be selected by the Service Above Self Scholarship Committee that includes representatives from the Rotary Club of Dunwoody and Dunwoody High School teachers
- Student must have been accepted to a post-secondary degree program at a two- or four-year college or university or a vocational/technical school

To Qualify for Subsequent Scholarship Renewals (up to 3 additional years)

Student must:

- Maintain an annual GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Participate actively in community service project(s) each year and provide a written summary of those volunteerism efforts annually by June
- Give a brief presentation of volunteer activities at a Rotary Club of Dunwoody meeting each summer

Renewals are also subject to Rotary Club of Dunwoody's availability of funds.
