Destiny

<u>Sora</u>

Students have access to grade-level appropriate ebooks and audiobooks purchased by their local school libraries, the Educational Media Department of DeKalb County School District, and the DeKalb County Public Library.

<u>Sora Sweet Reads</u>, — a collection of 50 free juvenile and young adult ebooks (and select audiobooks) added to Sora for summer reading. This year's collection contains 35 titles for ES /MS and 15 titles for HS that are available from May 4 to August 17, 2022.

<u>AudiobookSYNC</u>, a free summer audiobook program for teens 13+, available until August 17, 2022. Users must register at the <u>AudioFile SYNC</u> website with your email address. Once registered, SYNC may send a confirmation email with instructions to:

- 1. Download the Sora app at https://www.overdrive.com/apps/sora/.
- 2. Enter the setup code: audiobooksync.
- 3. Sign into the SYNC collection using the same email address used to sign up for the program.
- 4. Borrow and enjoy the featured titles.

If you wish to use Sora via LaunchPad, you will need to add the SYNC program's library using the steps below:

- 1. In Sora, open the menu (in the top-right corner).
- 2. Select "Add a library".
- 3. Search for **audiobooksync** and select this library from the results.
- 4. Enter the same email address you used to register for SYNC, if prompted.
